

"In children with a double parental history of atopic disease the incidence of such disease was higher than in children with a single such heredity in whom, however, the incidence was higher than in children without any parental history of atopic disease."

When history and examination are equivocal the use of IgE as a parameter for atopic allergy either for diagnostic or predictive purposes should be decisive.



A man of stature—in all ways—Henry Miller occupied a large part in many people's lives and his death in 1976 left a large gap. Though a neurologist of world renown he was best known in the North-East, where he spent most of his life, and where, for the last eight years of it, he was Vice-Chancellor of the University of Newcastle upon Tyne. A cross-section of his many friends and colleagues have contributed their reminiscences to Remembering Henry and, as each person saw him from a different angle, those who did not know him will find that the whole man gradually comes to life. 
